SVFD Pumper Truck Inspection: Beginning Sunday, June 08, 2025

The District of Stewart Volunteer Fire Department will be conducting an annual inspection of the SVFD Pumper Truck on Sunday, June 08, 2025. This is required as general maintenance for the Stewart Volunteer Fire Department equipment.

The Pumper Truck inspection process involves opening a fire hydrant and could result in water users experiencing temporary changes in water quality including: discoloured water, air in the water (giving water a milky white colour), silt, or a temporary drop in water pressure. Any issues should subside within 48 hours.

It is advised that residents limit their water use as much as possible if any changes in water quality are noticed. Discoloured water may stain clothing or dishes, so it is advisable to avoid using hot water, doing laundry or running the dish-washer.
