Prior to a planned power outage

- Make sure vehicles are fueled.
- Check that generators are ready and in good working order.
- Check batteries in flashlights and any other electronics you may require.

<u>During a planned power outage</u>

- Turn off all tools, appliances, and electronic equipment and turn the thermostat down to a minimum.
- Turn off all lights except for one indoor and one outdoor light.
- Don't open your freezer or fridge unless absolutely necessary. A full freezer will keep food frozen for 24-36 hours
- Never use a BBQ, camping equipment, or home generators indoors. They give off carbon monoxide, which you
 can't smell or see. It can be life-threatening.
- Protect sensitive electrical appliances with a surge-protecting power bar.
