With the weather improving and snow melting in Stewart, there has been a noticeable increase in the amount of dirt bike, ATV and side-by-side activity on the streets. This has the potential of becoming a safety issue with drivers of other motor vehicles having limited visibility of the riders. The Stewart RCMP wish to remind the residents of Stewart that dirt bikes, ATVs and side-by-sides are not legal to operate on public streets and should be limited to the dirt bike park in Stewart, private property or transported to areas outside of town to be used in off road areas. Dirt bikes that can legally be registered for use on public roads must display a license plate, and the rider must have a valid driver's license and follow local traffic laws.
